D. Treasurer – Ray L. Dec. 2007 & 2007 Overall

- **Income** for 2008 was below budget due primarily to Group Contributions under budget by roughly 10%, \$10,000. Literature sales were also down slightly for the year.
- The above decreases were somewhat offset by increased Individual Anonymous & Birthday contributions and increased 2007 Picnic revenue. An additional \$4,900 combined.
- Gross income (after literature expenses) for the year was \$135,404.26 versus \$141, 740 budgeted.
- **Expense** Insurance costs were under budget by \$800 due to a reduced General Liability policy cost
- Professional fees were under budget by \$1,500 due to reduced Accounting fees.

The office staff and the OOC are looking at ways to increase revenue and reduce expenses.
