Income

- Total Income for January exceeded budget projections by roughly 25% or \$5,600. All line items met or exceeded budget for the month.
- The above increases primarily consist of Increased AAWS literature sales; \$8,943.29 actual vs \$7,625 projected.
- Group contributions far exceeded budget at \$12,949 actual vs \$8,416 projected.
- Anonymous & Birthday contributions and Office Services revenue all exceeded projection.
- The newly initiated Faithful Fivers program is off on a very positive note and has contributed several hundred additional dollars to date. Please encourage your group members to participate.
- Gross profit for January was \$16,985.38 versus \$12,500 budgeted.

Expense – Expenses for 2008 will be paid on an "as occurred" basis versus last minute

- Office expense was exceeded by roughly \$200+, increases were in postage & delivery and replenishment of office supplies primarily.
- Utilities were exceeded by almost \$300 due to paying Gas & Electric on a pay as occurred basis.
- Professional fees were under by \$168 due to less than projected Accounting and Network Admin costs.
- Payroll expenses were under slightly by \$240.
