Colusa County Board of Supervisors Votes to Protect Civil Rights

Citizens Free to Resume Normal Functions, Encouraged to Exercise Kindness

(COLUSA, CA) May 28, 2020 – At a Special Meeting on May 27th, the Colusa County Board of Supervisors took formal action to abstain from enforcing any COVID-19 (Coronavirus) guidance or orders that infringe upon a citizen’s constitutional rights, including Governor Newsom’s Shelter-in-Place Order. Supervisor Gary J Evans made the motion, which was then adopted unanimously by the full Board.

“The Colusa County Board of Supervisors support all citizens, businesses, schools, churches, and organizations in exercising their constitutional rights,” stated Supervisor Evans. “And we would ask that the Sheriff, District Attorney, the cities of Colusa and Williams, and their respective Police Chiefs support this motion.”

The action allows for the reopening of all business and other service sectors within Colusa County. Colusa County citizens are free to resume all normal functions as they desire, with the request to exercise kindness, and good judgement.
